It was suggested that the District Steward be invited to attend a CGPC meeting.

6. CHILLERTON AND GATCOMBE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

A verbal report was given by Cllr Philips.

Currently the CGCA has a hard-working committee of 5 but hopefully, two younger members will be co-opted in the near future.

The Gallybagger has been open since July with a brief closure over Christmas due to the pandemic. A covid grant has been received to help financially with the closures. Many local organisations now use the Gallybagger for their meetings and with quiz's, table tennis and fish and chip suppers, it is now an integral part of the villages. The gable end and fencing has now been fixed.

The Christmas tree be replaced with a planted tree in the Autumn.
