### 3. Treasurer's Report

January has been a high expenditure month, specifically; painting of Village Hall, also Gallybagger water softener and hot water boiler repairs. In order to terminate the payments to SSE in March, we are currently paying in excess so as to be able to terminate our contract then, after which, we will switch to Octopus Energy. OE will bill monthly (not quarterly), and we will be on a Smart Meter.

JL informed us that Virgil Philpott is now the new Clerk, initially in a temporary capacity. An emergency PC meeting had been called to set the precept. VP has asked that we hold fire for the time being, regarding going forward with the Noticeboards.

## 5.Forthcoming Activities/ Bookings

**Action: PV to ask Beardsalls for the image file for Scarecrows; JB to assist.**
- Stargazing Evening- PP reported that this is almost full up. **Action: PP to ask Elaine (VAS), what equipment she requires. Action: PV to produce QR codes for the evening. Action: JT & JL to make (or buy!) biscuits. Action: PP, IP, JB, PV to help set up and serve drinks. (Tea, Coffee, Hot Chocolate, Squash)**
- Race Night- The decision was made to leave this until June. PV to lead.
- Take Away Evenings- JL & JB to trial this on 21st February while they are both on Gallybagger duty.  
**Action: JL to lead on this.**

## 6.Village Hall Windows & Gallybagger Roof

PV reported that she had got a quote from Pretty Windows, Rookley, and that she was in the process of applying for a grant to help with the costs. Please refer to PV for more detail, if required. One window is urgent, the rest may be able to be phased, but one window only, might preclude any grant application. **Action: PV to get some additional quotes, and to look closely at the benefits of phasing the works.**

PT reported that he had received several quotes for the repair of the Gallybagger roof. Please refer to PT for more detail, if required. **Action: PT to ask Shaun Jones for a quote. Action: PP to place on to the March agenda for further discussion.**

## 7.Purchase of TV

Any future purchase would be under the auspices of being a Sports & Social Club. The majority of the Committee prefer a TV with a stand, as opposed to a permanent wall mounting. We decided to hold fire for the time being, but to revisit at the March or April meeting. **Action: PP to put on March/ April agenda.**
