Place and length of verge Top of sunken lane at start of Loverstone Lane to bridleway junction G15 coming down from Lynchets	
Verge type and orientation. Is it steep/flat/shaded/NSEW/hedged behind/fenced/beside wood/beside arable or pasture East-facing side fairly steep with fence and residual hawthorn hedge below pasture West-facing verge flatter with hedge	
Plants have finished flowering Celandine, violet	
Plants in flower Frequent Red Campion, White Deadnettle, Buttercup, Cow Parsley, Stitchwort, Broad-leaved Dock, Herb Robert, Lady's Bedstraw, Bugle, Germander Speedwell, Ribwort Plantain, Dandelion, Lords and Ladies Occasional Hedge Mustard, Vetch	
Plants with foliage or are about to flower Frequent – Nettle Occasional – Hop, Elder Honeysuckle, Dog Rose, Blackberry, Agrimony, Hogweed, Convolvulus, Thistles, Perennial Sow Thistle
