2010 ENVIROMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS

- Furniture Maintenance:
  - Wobbly Aeroplane – the Clerk has not received any quotes on installation of the wobbly aeroplane and has contacted IOWC for information on who they use as contractors.
  - Compost Bin on Village Green – the Clerk reported that the Turners would have been happy to accept the grass cuttings from the play area and village green but have no way of transporting the cuttings. It was agreed that the Clerk would speak to David Hayden to see if he would be willing to transport the cuttings to the Turners compost bin and at what cost

**RESOLVED: that, the Clerk would contact Davis Hayden to ask if he would be willing to transport the grass cuttings to the Turners compost bin and what the extra cost could be.**

- World Wars Memorial Project – Held over to next meeting

- Tree Work on the Village Green – 2 quotes have been received for the work required on the Village Green, both in excess of £2000. It was suggested that the PC Insurance company be contacted to ask if our policy would cover the work required on dangerous trees.
