Place and length of verge Ramsdown Farmhouse driveway, West, to G15 Footpath	
Verge type and orientation. Is it steep/flat/shaded/NSEW/hedged behind/fenced/beside wood/beside arable or pasture This is a half- banked verge & hedgerow with a fence behind – no trees. There is a length of mixed hedging, beech, hawthorn & bramble in front of the fence, the rest is mostly grasses and wildflowers.	
Plants have finished flowering Snowdrops – every Jan/ Feb Daffodils – every Feb/Mar/Apr	
Plants in flower Stitchwort – F Blackthorn – just one sprig right by the footpath – every Mar/Apr. White deadnettle - F Celandine – F Dandelion – F Cow Parsley - F	
Plants with foliage or are about to flower Ivy Common Nettle Ferns – sorry don't know which ones they are! Various grasses.
