Place and length of verge Westward sunken lane from valley bottom up to chalk downland approx. ¼ mile	
Verge type and orientation. Is it steep/flat/shaded/NSEW/hedged behind/fenced/beside wood/beside arable or pasture Mostly shaded under mixed woodland canopy, steep sided, bordered by pasture (below) and arable (above). At top verges congested from hedge cuttings.	
Plants have finished flowering	
Plants in flower At bottom of lane south facing – Lords and Ladies,celandine Under tree canopy – Herb Robert, primrose, dandelion At top of lane – dog violet	
Plants with foliage or are about to flower At bottom of lane south facing – nettle, cow parsley, goose grass, bramble, ivy, snowdrop Under tree canopy – ransoms, burdock, buttercup, dock, harts tongue fern, red campion, cinquefoil, male fern, hog weed, bluebell At top of lane – lesser stitchwort, stinking iris, lesser plantain
